Below is an outline of the assumptions used in creating the Budget Report for the 2021 CVTRS submittal for Cascade Charter Township.

Historical Trends – Absent of the below explanations, the Township looks at three years of audited activity when making budget projections.

Revenues

- Real Tax Revenues Real Property tax revenues estimates are based on Taxable Values provided by the Assessing Department. For FY2022, Real Property tax revenues estimated to increase 3.48%
- State Shared Revenue Estimates for State Shared Revenue is based on estimates published by the State of Michigan

Expenditures

- Wages Wage increases are assigned on a case-by-case basis, but the total authorized wage increase
 for the organization is set by the Township Board. For FY 2022 the authorized total wages increase was
- Benefits Estimated benefits costs are based on information provided by benefit providers
- Special Projects These are one-time expenditures (i.e. a Master Plan Update) and estimates are provided by Department Heads based on their research.
- Capital Improvements The are one-time expenditures (i.e. a New Fire Truck) and estimates are
 provided by Department Heads based on their research.
